## ORCHIS PURPUREA ROSATO DI AGLIANICO



Nimphae Sacrae is the tombstone specular to those of Iovi Tonant in the palatial chapel of the D'Avalos in the heart of Montesarchio, company headquarters. These are the two surviving votive gravestones of the Roman temple, later used in the Annunziata vecchia cathedral devastated by the Arabs in the 19th century.

### WINEMAKING

From the Bitter Aglianico of the Taburno, the bunches are harvested at the end of September, beginning of October, the pressing takes place with a short stop with the skins, then the fermentation in steel and a small stop in second passage barriques, after three months the bottling.

### ORGANOLEPTIC DESCRIPTION

Pink color, with amaranth reflections. Intense aromas, velvety tannins.
